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## Terms and Conditions

All applications for the Residential Water Saving Incentive Scheme 2006/07 are subject to the following Terms and Conditions:

Applications under the Residential Water Saving Incentive Scheme 2006/07 apply to products purchased by the applicant between 1 July 2006 and 30 June 2007, and only products listed in the Eligible Products List below. Purchase date is determined by the date shown on the original purchase receipt.

To be eligible for a rebate, you must complete the Application form in full and mail it to Logan Water along with the **original purchase receipt** and any other specified information. Photocopies of original receipts will not be accepted as proof of purchase unless accompanied by a statutory declaration.

**Receipts will not be returned to the applicant.** It is recommended that you keep a photocopy of receipts, or ask your retailer for a duplicate copy.

**Applications may only be submitted on behalf of a household.** A household is defined as a residential household that lies within the boundaries of the City of Logan. Businesses and other non residential establishments are not eligible to apply.

By submitting a completed Application form that meets these Terms and Conditions, the applicant certifies that they duly represent the household identified by the address on the application.

### Rebates

The amount of a rebate actually paid is calculated according to the product purchased as set out in the Eligible Products List. The maximum total of rebates that will be issued to one household is as specified in the eligible product list.

**All applications will receive payment of the rebate by cheque delivered by mail.**

Purchases must be equal to or greater than the value of minimum spend requirements specified below.

Applicants must repay any rebates provided if any of these Terms and Conditions are found to have been breached.

### Eligible Products

Rebates apply only to new products and do not apply to previously used or second-hand products. Rebates only apply after the product has been purchased, paid in full, and physically installed in the household.

It is a condition of the rebate that the product(s) must remain in the household for the period that the applicant owns or controls the product(s) or owns or remains in the household.

Delivery charges are not eligible for rebates and will not be considered as a component of a relevant minimum spend requirement.

Only products that are listed below are eligible for the specified rebates:

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## Eligible Product List

### Swimming Pool Covers (minimum 25m<sup>2</sup>, minimum 3mm thickness)

A \$200 rebate applies to the purchase of a swimming pool cover with a minimum 25 square metre surface area and a minimum of 3 millimetres in overall thickness.

A minimum spend of \$350 on the swimming pool cover and its installation is required.

The purchase of the pool cover rollers are not included in this program.

This rebate will only apply one (1) time per household over the entire life of the scheme and any of its earlier versions.

Applications must be accompanied by an original purchase receipt that clearly shows:

- The type of product purchased;
- The location where the product was purchased;
- The date that the product was purchased;
- Payment in full;
- The address of either the purchaser or the product's delivery destination; and,
- The square area of the swimming pool cover in metres.
- The thickness of the swimming pool cover

Logan Water or Logan City Council reserves the right to inspect the swimming pool cover within one (1) month of receiving the Residential Water Saving Incentive Scheme 2006/07 application.

### Rainwater Tanks

#### Summary of Building Regulations

Building Regulations require rainwater tanks to fall within the following dimensions inclusive of any stand or base:

- Maximum height of 2.4 metres.
- All sides to be less than 5 metres
- Plan area to be less than 10 square metres.
- Underground or semi-submerged tanks must be less than one metre below ground.

Building regulations will limit the location of a rainwater tank on your property. These siting requirements will vary according to the height of the tank and the dimensions of your property. In most properties, rainwater tanks should be:

- Set back from the road boundary by at least 6 metres;
- Tanks less than 1 metre above ground level can be located up to the front property boundary;
- Separated from underground stormwater and sewerage pipes by at least 2 metres
- Where the tank is positioned between an existing dwelling and rear or side boundaries the tank must be located at a distance of 900mm from the existing dwelling or 450mm from the rear or side boundaries.

Reduced rear and side boundary clearances will apply for narrow blocks and height restrictions for corner blocks.

#### General conditions of rainwater tank rebate

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A \$500 rebate applies to the purchase and installation of a rainwater tank which is for domestic external use only and not used to top up a swimming pool. Where a rainwater tank is used externally for watering of gardens and topping up of a swimming pool, an application should be made to the state government under their cash rebate scheme in the first instance, and if rejected, an application for the Council rebate will be considered. This rebate will only apply once per household over the entire life of the scheme and its earlier versions.

Applications must be accompanied by an original purchase receipt that clearly shows:

- The type of product purchased
- The location where the product was purchased
- The date the product was purchased
- Payment in full
- The address of the purchaser or products delivery destination
- The capacity or volume of the rainwater tank

Evidence that the rainwater tank has been installed must be shown including a photograph of installed rainwater tank must be submitted showing the overflow connection to stormwater or to a rubble pit where the stormwater connection is unavailable.

Applicants agree to accept all responsibility for consulting building regulations and ensuring that rainwater tanks are installed according to those guidelines.

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## Other Terms and Conditions

### Research

Information on the application form may be used to measure and monitor the success of the scheme. Rebate recipients consent to and recognise that Logan Water may contact them to conduct research about the products purchased.

### Program Changes

Logan Water reserves the right, at its sole discretion and at any time, to change any or all of the Terms and Conditions for the 2006/07 residential water saving incentive scheme. Applications must be received by Logan Water prior to any published termination date for the 2006/07 residential water saving incentive scheme. Termination notification will appear in the Public Notices Section of the local media.

### Liability

The applicant(s) acknowledges and agrees that as far as the law permits, Logan Water and Logan City Council accept no liability in respect of any claim, cause or action or loss or damage arising out of, or in relation to any Eligible Product that is the subject of the scheme. The applicant(s) agrees that they will indemnify and keep indemnified Logan Water and Logan City Council from any claim or liability arising out of, or in relation to, the Eligible Products that are the subject of this application to the extent that any claim or liability is not caused by Logan Water or Logan City Council's negligence or breach of this application or any other term implied by law.
