

Terms and Conditions

All rebates apply only to domestic projects and do not cover renting, leasing, hiring arrangements or commercial applications.

1. To be eligible for a Waterwise Rebate, you must complete in full and sign the rebate form and include all of the requested original tax invoices.
2. Details provided may be used to audit that the products purchased have been installed correctly to guidelines and within the Terms and Conditions of the Waterwise Rebate Program.
3. The total offer of rebates offered is limited to a period of 24 months duration and will not be extended without review.
4. Rebates apply to purchases completed after 11 February 2003, for washing machines, showerheads, garden bores and rainwater tanks. After 11 February 2004 for tap timers, soil wetting agents and in-tap flow regulators greywater re-use systems and aerobic treatment units. And after 1 July 2005 for swimming pool covers, subsurface irrigation pipework, rain sensors and Waterwise garden assessments.
5. Elements of the Waterwise Rebate Program are subject to change without notice.
6. Although original tax invoices and receipts will be returned to you, it is recommended that you keep a photocopy.
7. Rebates are only available to residential properties that are habitable.
8. Rebates not available for commercial properties or purposes.

Swimming Pool Covers

9. The Waterwise Rebate of \$100 (capped at 50% of the total cost) is only available for swimming pool covers endorsed under the Smart Approved Watermark Scheme with a minimum warranty of 8 years. These are listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
10. Rebates apply to purchases completed on or after 1 July 2005.
11. The rebate is limited to one pool cover per domestic household.
12. The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the item is purchased.
13. The customer must attach the tax invoice or receipt, stating the make and model number of the pool cover, to the completed rebate form in order to be eligible for a rebate.

Rain Sensors

14. The Waterwise Rebate of \$20 is only available for rain sensors endorsed under the Smart Approved Watermark Scheme. These are listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
15. Rebates apply to purchases completed on or after 1 July 2005.
16. The rebate is limited to one rain sensor per domestic household.
17. The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the item is purchased.
18. The customer must attach the tax invoice or receipt, stating the make and model number of the rain sensor, to the completed rebate form in order to be eligible for a rebate.

Subsurface Irrigation Systems

19. The Waterwise Rebate of \$10 is only available for 30m rolls of subsurface irrigation pipework endorsed under the Smart Approved Watermark Scheme. These are listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
20. Rebates apply to purchases completed on or after 1 July 2005.
21. The rebate is limited to 10 rolls of subsurface irrigation pipework per domestic household.
22. The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the item is purchased.
23. The customer must attach the barcode from the product packaging and the original receipt to the completed rebate form in order to be eligible for a rebate.

Waterwise Garden Assessments

24. The Waterwise Rebate of \$30 is only available for Waterwise garden assessments performed by endorsed Water Corporation Waterwise Garden Centres. These are listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
25. Rebates apply to assessments conducted on or after 1 July 2005.
26. The rebate is limited to one Waterwise garden assessment per domestic household.
27. The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the assessment is conducted.
28. The customer must attach the tax invoice or receipt and a copy of the Waterwise garden assessment, to the completed rebate form in order to be eligible for a rebate.

Terms and Conditions

Showerheads

29. The Waterwise Rebate of \$10 is only available for showerheads with 3 'Stars' (or 3 'A' rating until 31 Dec 2005) and can be viewed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
30. The rebate is applicable for a maximum of two showerheads per household.
31. The customer may apply for the rebate as soon as the item is purchased.
32. Proof of purchase, in the form of an original tax invoice and barcode from product packaging must be provided with the completed rebate form.

Washing Machines

33. The Waterwise Rebate of \$150 is only available for washing machines with a rating of 4 'Stars' (or 5 'A' or above until 31 Dec 2005) listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
34. The rebate is limited to one washing machine per domestic household.
35. The rebate is available once the washing machine has been installed and is operational.
36. A tax invoice or receipt, stating the make and model number of the washing machine and showing payment in full, is required to receive the rebate.
37. Offer not valid for secondhand washing machines, rental agreements or commercial applications.

Rainwater tanks

38. To be eligible for a rebate, properties must be serviced from a scheme water supply, or have carted water from a scheme water supply within the past 12 months, and are using the water for domestic purposes only. Customers who have carted scheme water must sign a declaration form confirming the above. Forms can be obtained by contacting the Water Corporation on 1300 133 646.
39. A \$50 rebate applies for purchase and installation of new tanks over 600 litres.
40. Up to \$500 (capped at 50% of the purchase and plumbing costs) is available if the tank has a capacity greater than 2,000 litres and is plumbed in for toilet and/or washing machine use at the time

of installation. Plumbing into the house must be undertaken by a licensed plumber, in accordance with plumbing by-laws.

41. Original tax invoice for purchase, and if claiming the maximum rebate, original tax invoice and receipt for plumbing work must be submitted with the completed rebate form.
42. You must check with your local council for approval prior to purchase and installation.
43. When installing rainwater tanks, you must ensure you have adequate mosquito controls.
44. One rebate per household to a maximum of \$500.

Bores

45. To be eligible for a rebate, properties must be serviced from a scheme water supply, or have carted water from a scheme water supply within the past 12 months, and are using the water for domestic purposes only. Customers who have carted scheme water must sign a declaration form confirming the above. Forms can be obtained by contacting the Water Corporation on 1300 133 646.
46. A Waterwise Rebate of \$300 per residential property (capped at 50% of the installation costs) is available for the drilling of domestic garden bores.
47. If the garden bore is installed by a licensed driller you must submit, with the completed rebate form, the licensed driller's details together with original tax invoice and receipts.
48. Electrical work for all bores must be in accordance with the Electricity (Licensing) Regulations 1991.
49. For bores installed by persons other than licensed drillers, tax invoices and receipts for items used in the installation and electrical work must be included with the completed rebate form.
50. The rebate is only applicable to successful bores that deliver water.
51. Properties sharing a bore must be adjoining to be eligible for the rebate.
52. Rebate not valid for bore maintenance, new pumps, reticulation or share bore hook-up to an existing bore.

Terms and Conditions

Greywater Re-use Systems and Aerobic Treatment Units

53. The Waterwise Rebate is only available for greywater re-use systems and aerobic treatment units that are approved by the Department of Health, and are listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
54. The rebate is limited to one greywater re-use system or one aerobic treatment unit per domestic household.
55. A Waterwise Rebate of up to \$500 applies for greywater re-use systems and aerobic treatment units purchased on or after 11 February 2004.
56. The rebate is available for both sewered and non sewered residential properties.
57. The rebate is available once the greywater re-use system or the aerobic treatment unit has been installed and a "Permit to Use Apparatus" has been received from Local Government (Shire).
58. A rebate will only be granted for greywater re-use systems or aerobic treatment units where the effluent is used for irrigation purposes.
59. Installation of the greywater re-use system or aerobic treatment unit must be undertaken by a licensed plumber in accordance with plumbing by-laws.
60. When claiming for a rebate an original tax invoice of purchase and for plumbing work must be submitted with the completed rebate form.

Tap Timers

61. The Waterwise Rebate of \$10 is only available for automatic tap timers listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
62. Rebates apply to purchases completed on or after 11 February 2004.
63. The approved tap timer must be able to accommodate two day per week water restrictions by allowing sprinklers to operate for an allocated time, on two specific days at specific times of the day (e.g. 15 minutes on Wednesday and Saturday).
64. The rebate is limited to a maximum of two tap timers per domestic household.
65. The customer must include the barcode information from the product packaging and attach the original receipt, to the completed rebate form, to be eligible for a rebate.

Soil Wetting Products

66. The Waterwise Rebate of \$10 is only available on soil wetting products listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
67. Rebates apply to domestic purchases completed on or after 11 February 2004.
68. A rebate of \$10 per household is applicable to customers who purchase either 10kg of granulated agent or two litres of liquid concentrate. If multiple packages (i.e. two 5kg packs) are purchased, it must be in a single transaction.
69. The rebate is limited to a maximum of two soil wetting products purchased per residential property each year from 1 July 2005.
70. The customer must include on the completed rebate form, the barcode number from the product packaging and attach the original receipt to be eligible for a rebate.
71. Rebate not valid for commercial purposes or applications.

In-Tap Flow Regulators

73. The Waterwise Rebate of \$10 is only available on in-tap flow regulators with a rating of '4' Stars (or 4 'A' until 31 Dec 2005) listed on the www.ourwaterfuture.com.au website.
74. Rebates apply to purchases completed on or after 11 February 2004.
75. In-tap flow regulators must be installed by a licensed plumber.
76. The rebate is limited to a maximum of 10 installed in-tap flow regulators per domestic household.
77. The customer must attach to the completed rebate form, the plumber's tax invoice and receipt as proof of installation of an approved in-tap flow regulator to be eligible for a rebate. The invoice must state the make and model of the regulator.
